OUR PARK RULES

Palmerston Lake Campground is a happy family-oriented place. Specific rules are necessary of course, to help keep it that way. We ask that you read and understand these rules. Please see Frank Cho at the office if there are any questions.

- 'Quiet time' is from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Sundays through Thursday, and from 12 midnight to 7:00 a.m. Friday and Saturday evenings. During quiet time, no noise may be made which can be heard beyond the immediate vicinity of your site.
- Visitors must check in at the office, and after paying the appropriate fee, park in the designated area. No visitor will be allowed to enter the park after 10:00 p.m. Overnight visitors must be authorized by the management.
- No amplified instrumental or vocal music is allowed at any time on the campsite, except in the designated area, or with management permission.
- Car speed limit in the park is 5 m/h. (8 km/h). We encourage pedestrian and bicycle traffic in the park. Cars do not have the right of way. Bicycles not to be used after dusk.
- No motorcycles / ATV will be allowed in the park, unless being escorted by the management to a site.
- Campers 18 years of age and under must be accompanied by a parent when staying overnight.
- No porch, add-a-room, shed, eating tent or other tents may be allowed on site without permission of the management.
- Car washing is not permitted.
- Absolutely, no tree cut on the premises without management permission.
- Temporary clotheslines will be allowed for drying towels and bathing suits only. No laundry may be hung.
- Parents are responsible for the action of their children, or children under their care.
- Day visitors will be permitted only at the discretion of management.
- Pets are welcome but must be secured at all times. Owners of pets must remove animal droppings.
- Garbage must be secured in plastic bags and well lidded vessel.
- Sales and/or rentals of any units on the premises must be handled by Palmerston Lake Campground.
- Alcoholic beverages are allowed on trailer site only, and at recreation areas at the discretion of management.
- Boats and trailers to be stored **only at the designated spots** when not in use.
- Trailers with sloped, peaked and/or shingled roofs not be allowed, except by permission of management, on specific fence line or perimeter lots.
- The management **may evict** any guest or visitor who causes a disturbance, embarrassment, or in any other way annoys other guests.
- Palmerston Lake Campground, its management and staff, will not accept responsibility for loss or damage to personal property or persons, however caused.
